Form 1: Streaming Intention

- This form must be completed, and signed, by the team managers to indicate that the age group would like to stream. Please be as accurate as possible with the different stage dates.
- The form must be submitted the section manager at least two weeks before the proposed start date.
- Once the Section Manager Approves, the Head Coach will approve and the form will be passed onto the Chairman.
- Once these three approval stages have been confirmed, the section manager will give the green light to the teams.

Form 2: Proposed Streamed Squads:

- This form is to be filled out after the streaming sessions (training and inter-club games) have been completed.
- Both team managers must agree with the squads and sign the form.
- The form must be passed onto the Section Manager for approval.
- The Section Manager will have the authority to approve the proposed squads. The Head Coach and Chairman will only need to give approval if they have been involved within the Streaming process.

Form 3: 11V11 Streaming Application:

- This form must be completed, and signed, by the team managers to indicate that the age group would like to stream.
- The form must be submitted the section manager at least two weeks before the proposed start date
- Once the Section Manager Approves, the Head Coach will approve and the form will be passed onto the Chairman.
- Once these three approval stages have been confirmed, the section manager will give the green light to the teams.
- A brief statement on why the teams wish to stream must be provided
- Please be as accurate as possible with the different stage dates.

Form 4: 11V11 Re-trail application

- This form must be completed, and signed, by the team manager to indicate that the age group would like to stream.
- The form must be submitted the section manager at least two weeks before the proposed start date.
- Once the Section Manager Approves, the Head Coach will approve and the form will be passed onto the Chairman.
- Once the three club officials have approved the process, the section manager will give the green light to the teams.
- A brief statement on why the teams wish to stream must be provided
- Please be as accurate as possible with the different stage dates.

Form 5: Internal Transfer

- This form must be completed, and signed, by the team managers to indicate that the intention to internal transfer a player from one squad to another.
- The form must be submitted the section manager for approval
- Once the Section Manager Approves, the league paperwork can be completed for the process.

Four-Corner Player Review

- The Four-Corner Player Review sheet should be completed for every player to help with the Streaming Stage Two, as it will provide the foundation of discussing player's strengths and weaknesses.
- Coaches have opportunity to rank players on physical, technical, social and psychological age and provide comments on the players.
- This should be shared the other coach prior to the meeting Streaming Stage Two meeting.
