1 Benefits of Social Media

The social media used by NPLYFC include the club website, Instagram, Facebook and Twitter accounts. Teams also use Email, Whatsapp and other messaging platforms, as well as match organising apps such as Matchday and Teamer. There are many benefits of using social media including informing parents, celebrating successes, and promoting events.

2 Consent

The annual registration process at the club includes agreement from parents or carers to accept that images of their child may be used on club social media platforms. This can include posts that remain in place after the child has left the club. Where consent is not provided, or withdrawn, parents or carers should contact their team manager who will then inform other team parents and the club Welfare Officer.
